Subject: Guidelines for implementation of Amendment No. 2 to Indian Standard IS 2347: 2023- Domestic Pressure Cookers

1. Amendment No. 2 to IS 2347: 2017 has been published. **The last date for implementation of the Amendment is 16 December 2025.**
2. All BOs shall inform the Applicants and Licensees under their jurisdiction about implementation of the Amendment **within a week of issuance of these guidelines.**
3. The significant changes brought through this Amendment as listed in the Table below is given for the purpose of general guidance. BOs shall ensure that the product conforms to all the requirements, as applicable, of the Standard read along with its Amendments.

Sl. No.	Page No, Clause reference	Change
1.	Page 1, Cl. 5.1.1- Material of Body, Lid, Container and Grid	Additional grades of aluminium alloy as per IS 21 and IS 737 have been added. Also, a new note under this clause has been added to specify that the material shall not contain more than 0.05 percent as metal of any toxic metals such as lead, cadmium and arsenic.
2.	Page 3, Cl. 5.11- Material and pressure level for Pressure indicator, if indicator is provided	Correction in Standard reference for material of stainless steel rod and bars, and in pressure level has been made.
3.	Page 5, Cl. 8.1- Air leakage test	Procedure of the test has been modified to test the sample further in case of leakage observed.
4.	Page 7, Cl. 8.15.5- New clause added for lid fitted with the glass being used for pressure cooking	New clause has been added for lid fitted with the glass being used for pressure cooking, specifying requirements of such assembly.
5.	Page 8, Cl. 10.5.1 (c)- Instructions for use	It has now been specified that Aluminium cooker should not be used for deep frying.

4. Consequent upon issuance of the Amendment, existing Product Manual has also been revised as Doc: PM/ IS 2347/10/ September 2025. In this revision, changes have been made in requirements of raw material, Grouping Guidelines, Scope of licence and Scheme of Inspection and Testing as per the Amendment.
5. The guidelines for implementation of the Amendment is given below:

A. LICENSEES:

- (i) All Licensees shall implement the Amendment by 16 December 2025. Any difficulty in implementation shall be brought to the notice of CMD III within 30 days of issuance of these guidelines. BOs shall ensure that no Licences are under operation without Amendment after 16 December 2025. The status of implementation of the Amendment shall be confirmed by Head (BO) to CMD-III within two weeks of the last date of concurrent running.

- (ii) In order to establish conformity to Amendment, licensees shall submit test certificate of raw material indicating that the material does not contain more than 0.05 percent as metal of any toxic metals such as lead, cadmium and arsenic, as per Note under Cl. 5.1.1 of the Standard.
- (iii) Verification of implementation of the Amendment, shall be done during the next visit **which shall be completed within one month from the date of submission of compliance by licensee.**
- (iv) If the Licensee fails to complete all actions by 16 December 2025 it shall be dealt with as per the prevailing guidelines.

B. APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT OF LICENCE:

- (i) Existing Applications where Sample has been submitted in the Laboratory/Test Report has been issued by the Laboratory may be processed without Amendment. However, if the Applicant is desirous of considering the application as per the Amendment, a declaration may be obtained from the Applicant to that effect and the Application may be processed accordingly. An undertaking shall also be obtained from such Applicants that if the sample fails while considering the provisions of the Amendment, Licence will not be granted without Amendment.
- (ii) Applications which are recorded henceforth may be processed with or without Amendment. Processing of Applications without Amendment shall be permitted only up to 16 December 2025 and for such cases Applicant shall give a declaration that they will implement the Amendment by 16 December 2025.
- (iii) Beyond 16 December 2025 no Licence shall be granted without consideration of the Amendment.

C. CHANGE IN SCOPE OF LICENCE:

- (i) For change in scope of licence, the relevant provisions as given above for Applicants shall apply.
- (ii) However, processing of such applications for change in scope of licence without Amendment shall be permitted only upto the date of implementation of the Amendment by the licensee or up to 16 December 2025 whichever is earlier.

6. The above guidelines come into force with immediate effect.
