Subject: Guidelines for implementation of Amendment no. 3 to IS 17266:2019 – (Textiles – Viscose staple fibres – Specification)

1. Amendment no. 3 to IS 17266:2019 has been published. The amendment shall be implemented with effect from **1 Feb 2024**.
2. All BOs shall inform the Applicants and Licensees under their jurisdiction about implementation of the above amendment within a week of issuance of these guidelines.
3. The significant changes in the standard through this amendment as listed in the Table are given for the purpose of general guidance. BOs shall ensure that the product conforms to all the requirements, as applicable, as per the amendment.

Clause No.	Change
Table 1, SI No. (i), col (2)	The term “denier, max” has replaced with “Denier (as declared)”
Table 1, SI No. (i), col (3), (4), (5), (6)	Instead of maximum values, a tolerance of ± 7 percent has been specified on the values of Denier (as declared)
Table 1, SI No. (ii), clause 5	Requirements of conditioned tenacity have been modified to specify different values based on different ranges of denier The following note has been inserted under the packing clause ‘Viscose staple fibre bales may also be packed in any other packaging as agreed to between buyer and seller such that the contents are safe from weather, dirt, dust and water, etc.’
clause 6.1, SI No. (a) (2)	In the Marking clause, ‘Net mass of each package, that is, bale with SI. No.’ has been replaced with ‘Net mass and gross mass of each package, that is, bale with SI No.’

4. The guidelines for implementation of the amendment is given below:

A) LICENSEES:

i) All Licensees shall implement the amendment by **1 Feb 2024**. Any difficulty in implementation shall be brought to the notice of CMD 2 at the earliest but in any case at least 30 days before the last date of implementation. BOs shall ensure that no Licences are under operation as per IS 17266:2019 without the amendment after **1 Feb 2024**.

ii) Licensees shall submit evidence of conformity to the additional/modified requirements through In-house/Independent Test Reports or test certificates. Verification of implementation of the amendment, wherever required, **shall be verified through a surveillance visit within 30 days of confirmation of implementation of the amendment to standard by licensee.**

B) APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT OF LICENCE:

i) Existing Applications where Sample has been submitted in the Laboratory/Test Report has been issued by the Laboratory may be processed without consideration of the amendment. However, if the Applicant is desirous of considering the amendment, a declaration may be obtained from the Applicant to that effect and the Application may be processed accordingly. An undertaking shall also be obtained from such Applicants that if the sample fails while considering the provisions of the amendment, Licence will not be granted as per the old version.

ii) Applications which are recorded henceforth may be processed with or without consideration of the amendment. Processing of Applications without consideration of the amendment shall be permitted only upto **31 Jan 2024** and for such cases Applicant shall give a declaration that they will implement the amendment by **1 Feb 2024**.

iii) Beyond **1 Feb 2024** no Licence shall be granted without consideration of the amendment.

C) CHANGE IN SCOPE OF LICENCE:

i) For change in scope of licence, the relevant provisions as given above for Applicants shall apply.

ii) However, processing of such applications for change in scope of licence without consideration of the amendment shall be permitted only upto the date of implementation of the amendment by the licensee or upto **1 Feb 2024** whichever is earlier.

5. The above guidelines come into force with immediate effect.
