Subject: Guidelines for implementation of revised Indian Standard IS 11740: 2026 - “Motorcycle Chains — Characteristics and Test Methods”

1. IS 11740: 2014 / ISO 10190: 2008 has been revised and published as IS 11740: 2026. **The last date for implementation of the revised Standard is 27 September 2026.**
2. All BOs shall inform the Applicants and Licensees under their jurisdiction about implementation of the revised Standard **within a week of issuance of these guidelines.**
3. The significant changes brought through this revision as listed in the Table is given for the purpose of general guidance. BOs shall ensure that the product conforms to all the requirements, as applicable, as per the revised Standard.

| 3. | D-2, National Annex - D | A new clause has been introduced permitting the inclusion of various pitches, dimensions, and profile chains, which entails accommodating minor deviations as mutually agreed upon by manufacturers and purchasers. | Licensees shall submit the details of non-standard chains with minor deviations they intend to include in the scope of licence to concerned BOs through applications for Change in Scope of Licence (CSoL). |

4. Consequent upon revision of the Standard, existing Product Manual has also been revised as **PM/IS 11740/2/June 2026**. In this revision, changes have been made in Scope of Licence, Grouping Guidelines and Scheme of Inspection and Testing.
5. The guidelines for implementation of the revised Standard is given below:

A. LICENSEES:

- (i) All Licensees shall implement the revised Standard by **27 September 2026**. Any difficulty in implementation shall be brought to the notice of CMD III within 30 days of issuance of these guidelines. BOs shall ensure that no Licences are under operation as per the old Standard after **27 September 2026**. The status of implementation of the revised Standard shall be confirmed by Head (BO) to CMD-III within two weeks of the last date of concurrent running.
- (ii) This revision involves introduction of a new provision permitting the inclusion of various pitches, dimensions, and profile chains, hence no evidence of conformity needs to be submitted by the licensees for implementation of the revised Standard.
- (iii) Non-standard chains with minor deviations shall be included in the scope of licence through CSoL applications.
- (iv) Verification of implementation of the revised Standard, shall be done during the next visit **which shall be completed within one month from the date of submission of compliance by licensee.**

- (v) If the Licensee fails to complete all actions by **27 September 2026**, it shall be dealt with as per the prevailing guidelines.

B. APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT OF LICENCE:

- (i) Existing Applications where Sample has been submitted in the Laboratory/Test Report has been issued by the Laboratory may be processed as per the old Standard. However, if the Applicant is desirous of considering the application as per the revised Standard, a declaration may be obtained from the Applicant to that effect and the Application may be processed accordingly. An undertaking shall also be obtained from such Applicants that if the sample fails while considering the provisions of the revised Standard, Licence will not be granted as per the old version.
- (ii) Applications which are recorded henceforth may be processed as per old or revised Standard. Processing of Applications as per the old Standard shall be permitted only up to **27 September 2026** and for such cases Applicant shall give a declaration that they will implement the revised Standard by **27 September 2026**.
- (iii) Beyond **27 September 2026**, no Licence shall be granted without consideration of the revised Standard.

C. CHANGE IN SCOPE OF LICENCE:

- (i) For change in scope of licence, the relevant provisions as given above for Applicants shall apply.
- (ii) Non-standard chains with minor deviations shall be included in the scope of licence through CSoL applications.
- (iii) However, processing of such applications for change in scope of licence as per old Standard shall be permitted only upto the date of implementation of the revision by the licensee or up to **27 September 2026**, whichever is earlier.
6. The above guidelines come into force with immediate effect.
