Subject: Guidelines for implementation of Amendment No. 3 to Indian Standard IS 17790: 2022- “Insulated Flask for Domestic Use”

1. Amendment No. 3 to IS 17790: 2002 has been published. **The last date for implementation of the Amendment No. 3 is 14 June 2026.**
2. All BOs shall inform the Applicants and Licensees under their jurisdiction about implementation of the Amendment **within a week of issuance of these guidelines.**
3. The significant changes brought through this Amendment as listed in the Table is given for the purpose of general guidance. BOs shall ensure that the product conforms to all the requirements, as applicable, as per the Amendment.

1.	Page 1, Cl. 4.2.3; Page 3, Cl. 7.4; Table 2B	Now, cold retention capability requirements for Type 2 insulated flasks have also been specified. Cold retention capability requirement for Type 2 flasks have been specified in Table 2B.
2.	Page 9, Cl. B-1, Cl. B-2.1, B-2.1- Test method for cold retention capability	Test method has been modified to incorporate method of test for cold retention capability for Type 2 flasks.
3.	Page 8, clause 9.1- Marking requirements	New Note has been inserted at the end of Clause to specify that “Non-peelable sticker” can also be used for marking all the above details except the brand name and ISI marking. In such case, the sticker shall comply with the requirements as given in Annex G, including the Note under Annex-G.

4. Consequent upon publication of the Amendment, existing Product Manual has also been revised as Doc: PM/ IS 17790/4/ February 2026. In this revision, changes have been made in List of test equipment and Scheme of Inspection and Testing.
5. The guidelines for implementation of the revised Standard is given below:

A. LICENSEES:

- (i) All Licensees shall implement the Amendment by **14 June 2026**. Any difficulty in implementation shall be brought to the notice of CMD III within 30 days of issuance of these guidelines. BOs shall ensure that no Licences are under operation without the Amendment after **14 June 2026**. The status of implementation of the Amendment shall be confirmed by Head (BO) to CMD-III within two weeks of the last date of concurrent running.

- (ii) In order to establish conformity to the Amendment, licensee shall submit in-house or independent test report, as applicable, of the product to **new requirements** (Cold retention capability for type 2 flask as per Cl. 7.4.2), as applicable to the variety covered, as evidence of conformity to the revised Standard.
- (iii) Verification of implementation of the Amendment, shall be done during the next visit **which shall be completed within one month from the date of submission of compliance by licensee.**
- (iv) If the Licensee fails to complete all actions by **14 June 2026**, it shall be dealt with as per the prevailing guidelines.

B. APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT OF LICENCE:

- (i) Existing Applications where Sample has been submitted in the Laboratory/Test Report has been issued by the Laboratory may be processed without considering the Amendment. However, if the Applicant is desirous of considering the application with the Amendment, a declaration may be obtained from the Applicant to that effect and the Application may be processed accordingly. An undertaking shall also be obtained from such Applicants that if the sample fails while considering the provisions of the Amendment, Licence will not be granted without considering the Amendment.
- (ii) Applications which are recorded henceforth may be processed with or without the Amendment. Processing of Applications without the Amendment shall be permitted only up to **14 June 2026** and for such cases Applicant shall give a declaration that they will implement the Amendment by **14 June 2026**.
- (iii) Beyond **14 June 2026**, no Licence shall be granted without consideration of the Amendment.

C. CHANGE IN SCOPE OF LICENCE:

- (i) For change in scope of licence, the relevant provisions as given above for Applicants shall apply.
- (ii) However, processing of such applications for change in scope of licence without the Amendment shall be permitted only upto the date of implementation of the Amendment by the licensee or up to **14 June 2026**, whichever is earlier.

6. The above guidelines come into force with immediate effect.
