Subject: Guidelines for implementation of revised IS 5672: 2026 (Mineral Mixtures for Supplementing Poultry Feeds — Specification).

1. IS 5672: 1992, Mineral Mixtures for Supplementing Poultry Feeds — Specification, has been revised to IS 5672: 2026.
2. IS 5672: 1992, Mineral Mixtures for Supplementing Poultry Feeds — Specification are under concurrent running till 18th August 2026 and the last date for implementation of revised IS 5672: 2026 is 18th August 2026.
3. The major changes in IS 5672: 2026 in addition to updating of referred Indian Standard versions as well as addition of new alternatives in the test methods, due to the revision in comparison to IS 5672: 1992 is given below for general guidance:

2.	Table 1, Sl. No. ii	Calcium	Minimum calcium requirement reduced from 30% to 26%.
	Table 1, Sl. No. iii	Phosphorus	Test method has been modified.
3.	Table 1, Sl. No. iv	Iron	a) Minimum iron requirement reduced from 2000 ppm to 1700 ppm. b) Test method has been modified.
4.	Table 1, Sl. No. v	Iodine (as KI)	Minimum iodine requirement reduced from 0.01% to 0.008%.
5.	Table 1, Sl. No. vi	Copper	a) Minimum copper requirement reduced from 500 ppm to 400 ppm. b) Test method has been modified.
6.	Table 1, Sl. No. vii	Manganese	a) Minimum manganese requirement reduced from 0.40% to 0.30%. b) Test method has been modified.
7.	Table 1, Sl. No. viii	Fluorine	Maximum permissible fluorine limit reduced from 0.05% to 0.04%.
8.	Table 1, Sl. No. ix	Zinc	a) Minimum zinc requirement reduced from 0.40% to 0.33%. b) Test method has been modified.
9.	Cl 3.6	Supplementation guidance	Guidance text expanded to reflect additional supplement options.
10.	Cl 4.2 → Cl 4.2.1 & 4.2.2	Marking Requirements	New marking elements introduced.

4. Consequent upon the issuance of the revised Standard, the existing Product Manual has been revised.

5. The guidelines for implementation of the revised IS are as given below:

A. LICENSEES:

- a) Licensee shall implement the revised Indian Standard by 18th August 2026. Any difficulty in implementation shall be brought to the notice of CMD-2 within 30 days from the date of issuance of these guidelines. BO shall ensure that the no Licence is under operation as per IS 5672: 1992 (old standard) after 18th August 2026. The status of implementation of the revised Indian Standard shall be confirmed by Head (BO) to CMD-II within two weeks of the last date of implementation of concurrent running.
- b) Licensees shall submit evidence of conformity to the additional/modified requirements through In-house/Independent Test Reports or Test Certificates, as applicable.
- c) Licensee shall also submit declaration for additional Testing equipment in Form no. 2 as applicable, if testing of the parameter is done in-house or submit details of arrangement for testing of the parameters from independent lab (Subcontracting of the tests), in accordance with the Scheme of Inspection and Testing/QAP submitted by manufacturer.
- d) Verification of implementation of the revised Standard, wherever required, may be done during the next visit.
- e) If the Licensee fails to complete all actions by 18th August 2026, it shall be dealt with as per the prevailing guidelines.

B. APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT OF LICENCE:

- a) Existing Applications for GOL where Sample has been submitted in the Laboratory/Test Report has been issued by the Laboratory may be processed as per the old standard i.e. IS 5672: 1992. A declaration may be obtained from the Applicant that the Licence, if granted shall be switched over to IS 5672: 2026 before the last date of concurrent running of the ISs.
- b) Applications which are recorded henceforth may be processed as per as per old or revised Standard. Processing of Applications as per the old Standard, shall be permitted only up to 17th August 2026. For such cases Applicant shall give a declaration that they implement the revised Standard by 18th August 2026.
- c) Beyond by 18th August 2026, no Licence shall be granted as per IS 5672: 1992.

C. CHANGE IN SCOPE OF LICENCE:

- a) For change in scope of licence, the relevant provisions as given above for Applicants shall apply.
 - b) However, processing of such applications for change in scope of licence as per the old Standard shall be permitted only up to the date of implementation of the revised Standard or up to 18th August 2026, whichever is earlier.
6. BOs are requested to circulate this guideline to licensees and applicants immediately within 7 days of issuance of this circular.

7. The above guidelines come into force with immediate effect.
