#### NATIONAL FOREWORD

This standard was originally published in 2021, as adoption of ISO 18122: 2015 'Solid biofuels — Determination of ash content'. This (*first*) revision has been undertaken to align it with the latest version of ISO 18122: 2022 'Solid biofuels — Determination of ash content'.

The major changes in this revision are as follows:

- more detailed descriptions of the ashing furnace and ashing procedure;
- repeatability and reproducibility performance data updated;
- several references updated; and
- minor editorial corrections.

The text of ISO Standard has been approved as suitable for publication as an Indian Standard without deviations. Certain conventions are, however, not identical to those used in Indian Standards. Attention is particularly drawn to the following:

- a) Wherever the words 'International Standard' appear referring to this standard, they should be read as 'Indian Standard'.
- b) Comma (,) has been used as a decimal marker while in Indian Standards, the current practice is to use a point (.) as the decimal marker.

In this adopted standard, reference appears to the following International Standard for which Indian Standard also exists. The corresponding Indian Standard, which are to be substituted in their respective places, are listed below along with the degree of equivalence for the editions indicated:
