NATIONAL FOREWORD

This Indian Standard (Part 16) (First Revision) which is identical with ISO 603-16:2022 'Bonded abrasive products — Dimensions Part 16: Grinding wheels for cutting-off on hand held power tools' issued by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) will be adopted by the Bureau of Indian Standards on recommendation of the Abrasives Sectional Committee and approval by the Production and General Engineering Division Council.

This standard was originally published in 1999. This revision has been brought out to align it with ISO 603-16: 2022

The major changes in this revision are as follows:

- a) The title has been editorially corrected;
- b) Normative references have been updated;
- c) Terms and definitions have been added:
- d) Introductory, explanatory sentences have been added for better understanding; and
- e) The figures with shape types and dimensions have been adapted to ISO 551:2025 (For example in shape type 42, the dimension "F" for the elevation of depressed centre has been renamed "M").
