NATIONAL FOREWORD

This draft Indian Standard which is identical with ISO/FDIS 18060 ‘Sustainable Tourism — Indicators for Organizations in the Tourism Value Chain — Requirements and Guidance for Use’ issued by International Organization for Standardization (ISO) will be adopted by the Bureau of Indian Standards on recommendation of the Travel, Tourism, and Hospitality Related Services Sectional Committee, SSD 02 and approval of the Service Sector Division Council.

The text of ISO Standard has been approved as suitable for publication as an Indian Standard without deviations. Certain conventions are, however, not identical to those used in Indian Standards. Attention is particularly drawn to the following:

- a) Wherever the words ‘International Standard’ appear referring to this standard, they should be read as ‘Indian Standard’.
- b) Comma (,) has been used as a decimal marker while in Indian Standards, the current practice is to use a point (.) as the decimal marker.

In reporting the result of a test or analysis made in accordance with this standard, if the final value, observed or calculated, is to be rounded off, it shall be done in accordance with IS 2: 1960 ‘Rules for rounding off numerical values (revised)’. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be same as that of the specified value in this standard.

Scope of ISO/FDIS 18060 is as follows:

This document defines and establishes methodologies for a set of indicators to steer and measure the performance of organizations in terms of sustainability.

The requirements and guidance in this document can be used to implement these tourism sustainability indicators.

This document is applicable to any organization in the tourism value chain that wishes to:

- a) monitor, measure, analyse and evaluate the sustainability performance of the organization;
- b) ensure its conformity with its defined sustainability policy;
- c) measure, evaluate and monitor the results of sustainable practices implemented at the organization;
- d) evaluate the fulfilment of the established sustainability objectives;
- e) monitor compliance with applicable legislation
