Introduction

Stationery items and several other general products used in office play a vital role in ensuring the smooth and efficient functioning of any workplace. From basic writing and printing items and paper products to filing systems, electronic and IT equipment, furniture, products used in canteens, hygiene & personal care products etc support daily administrative tasks and contribute to overall productivity of an organization.

Adhering to the standards during procurement of office items help in maintaining quality, compatibility, and safety across a wide range of products.

This compendium aims at providing a comprehensive information of Indian Standards formulated by Bureau of Indian Standards related to general stationery items, equipment and consumables commonly used in office premises. In this compendium, various products used in offices have been categorized into sectors and sector wise availability of standards formulated by BIS have been mentioned.

By consolidating these standards into a single reference document, the compendium serves as a useful guide for procurement of office items.

1. Stationery Items

A wide range of stationery items are used in offices such as paper including paper for writing & photocopying, computer printing purpose, pens & refills, pencils, bill registers, stamp pads, gums, correction fluids, file tags etc. By adhering to standardized products, an organization can streamline procurement, reduce waste, and ensure smooth interoperability between devices (e.g. printers and copiers). BIS has formulated various standards on stationery items used in offices as listed below. Purchasing stationery items conforming to BIS standards enhances reliability and leads to cost savings through bulk buying and reduced need for customization.

2. Electronics & IT Solutions

In today's digital era, it is nearly impossible for any office to function without electronic and IT equipment such as computers, printers, keyboards, UPS systems etc. By adhering to standards during office procurements of these goods, offices can minimize risks related to electrical hazards, data security, system incompatibility and ensure safety, performance and energy efficiency. BIS has formulated number of standards on electronics and IT items used in offices as listed below. Purchasing electronics and IT equipment as per BIS standards will ensure long-term value and user safety. These standards are as follows:

3. Electrical Items

A wide range of electrical items are used in offices to support daily operations and to ensure a safe and comfortable working environment. These include power cables, batteries, circuit breakers, plugs & sockets etc. The BIS has formulated various standards for electrical items commonly used in office settings. Procuring electrical items conforming to BIS standards will promote energy efficiency and reduces repeated repair costs through enhanced durability and reduced equipment failure. The standards formulated by BIS in this sector for following products:

5. Health, Hygiene and Personal Care Items

A wide range of health, hygiene, and personal care products are essential in maintaining cleanliness, safety, and comfort in offices. These include items such as towels, dusters, yoga mats, soaps, detergents, toilet paper, glass cleaners, insecticides etc. In addition, personal protective equipment like respiratory masks, safety footwear etc play a vital role in ensuring personal safety and hygiene. Adhering to BIS standards as listed below for these items reduce the risks associated with the substandard products.


