INSULATING VARNISHES CONTAINING SOLVENTS

PART 1 DEFINITIONS AND GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1 SCOPE

This standard (Part 1) applies to electrical insulating varnishes containing solvent which, after solvent removal and curing, become non-thermoplastic. This part of the specification contains the definitions related to and the general requirements for such varnishes.
