### **GLOSSARY OF TERMS RELATING TO RIVER VALLEY PROJECTS**

#### **PART XIV SOIL CONSERVATION AND RECLAMATION**

##### **Section I Soil Conservation**

#### **1. SCOPE**

**1.1** This standard (Part XIV/Sec 1) covers the definitions of terms relating to soil conservation.

**NOTE** – Throughout this standard, the terms ‘bound’ and ‘embankment’ are used synonymously.

#### **FOREWORD**

**0.1** This Indian Standard ( Part XIV/Sec 1 ) was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 31 March 1977, after the draft finalized by the Terminology Relating to River Valley Projects Sectional Committee had been approved by the Civil Engineering Division Council.

**0.2** A number of Indian Standards has already been printed covering various aspects of river valley projects and a large number of standards are in ‘the process of formulation. These standards include technical terms, the precise definitions of which are required to avoid ambiguity in their interpretation. ‘TO achieve this and, the Institution is bringing out this glossary of terms relating to river valley projects ( IS : 4410 ) which is being published in parts. The other parts of this standard so far published are given on page 26.

**0.3** Part XIV covers the important field of soil conservation and reclamation and in view of the vastness of this subject, it is proposed to cover the subject in three sections. While this section covers terms relating to reclamation.
