SPECIFICATION FOR ZINC OXIDE SELF-ADHESIVE PLASTER

(First Revision)

0. FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard (First Revision) was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 15 February 1980, after the draft finalized by the Surgical Dressings Sectional Committee had been approved by the Consumer Products and Medical Instruments Division Council.

0.2 This standard was first published in 1968. Since then many suggestions were received for improvement. This standard is being revised to incorporate the suggestions received from time to time.

0.3 Zinc oxide self-adhesive plaster consists of a suitable cloth, coated uniformly on one side with a pressure sensitive adhesive mass containing zinc oxide. It is used to secure dressings, protect wounds and to immobilise small areas.

0.4 This standard contains clause **3.1** which calls for agreement between the purchaser and the supplier regarding dimensions.

0.5 For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is complied with, the final value, observed or calculated, expressing the results of a test or analysis, shall be rounded off in accordance with IS : 2-1960*. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value in this standard.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard covers requirements pertaining to material, construction and performance of zinc oxide self-adhesive plaster.
