## **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR TINTED OPHTHALMIC GLASS**

### **0. FOREWORD**

**0.1** This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 29 November 1971, after the draft finalized by the Optical and Mathematical Instruments Sectional Committee had been approved by the Mechanical Engineering Division Council.

**0.2** This standard deals with the requirements of tinted ophthalmic glass used for making sunglasses and tinted lenses. The requirements of non tinted ophthalmic glass are covered in IS:4382-1967\*.

**0.3** For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is complied with, the final value, observed or calculated, expressing the result of a test, shall be rounded off in accordance with IS : 2-1960†. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value in this standard.

### **1. SCOPE**

**1.1** This standard specifies requirements of tinted ophthalmic glass used for making sunglasses and tinted lenses.
