SPECIFICATION FOR FIRE HOOKS

FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard (Second Revision) was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 30 November 1981, after the draft finalized by the Fire Fighting Sectional Committee, had been approved by the Civil Engineering Division Council.

0.2 The function of a fire hook is to pierce ceiling to allow the water on the upper floor to drain away, to pull down thatched roofs or roofs made out of matting, pulling out bales and bags of various commodities from a distance, opening and closing down of doors and various similar jobs. This standard was first published in 1958 and revised in 1964. This revision incorporates the modifications in the design of the hook besides updating its other provisions.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard lays down the requirements regarding materials, shape and dimensions, workmanship, finish and performance for fire hooks.
