SPECIFICATION FOR DISK RECORD PLAYING EQUIPMENT

PART II AMPLIFIERS AND LOUDSPEAKERS

0 FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard (Part II) was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 31 December 1979, after the draft finalized by the Recording Sectional Committee had been approved by the Electronics and Telecommunication Division Council.

0.2 This standard (Part II) specifies the characteristics of amplifiers and loudspeakers of disk record playing equipment. Part I of this standard specifies the characteristics of record players of disk record playing equipment.

0.3 While preparing this standard, assistance has been derived from IEC Publication 98-1964 'Processed disk records and reproducing equipment', issued by the International Electrotechnical Commission.

0.4 For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is complied with, the final value, observed or calculated, expressing the result of a test, shall be rounded off in accordance with IS : 2- 1960*. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value in this standard.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard (Part II) covers the characteristics of amplifiers and loudspeakers of disk record playing equipment.
