

**(PREVIEW)***Indian Standard*SPECIFICATION FOR  
PROCESSED DISK RECORDS**0. FOREWORD**

**0.1** This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 18 September 1979, after the draft finalized by the Recording Sectional Committee had been approved by the Electronics and Telecommunication Division Council.

**0.2** This standard specifies the dimensional and other characteristics of processed mono and stereo disk records necessary to secure inter-changeability.

**0.3** While preparing this standard, assistance has been derived from IEC Publication 98-1964; Processed disk records and reproducing equipment issued by International Electrotechnical Commission.

**0.4** For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is complied with, the final value, observed or calculated, expressing the result of a test, shall be rounded off in accordance with IS : 2-1960\*. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value in this standard.
