FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard (Second Revision) was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 30 July 1981, after the draft finalized by the Fire Fighting Sectional Committee had been approved by the Civil Engineering Division Council.

0.2 This standard was first issued in 1950 and revised in 1965. In this revision, requirements for the water fittings have been incorporated for which Indian Standards are available till 1980. The revision also includes the details of specification of the rubber used for the manufacture of washers.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard lays down the requirements regarding material, shape, dimensions and finish of washers required for water fittings used for fire fighting purposes.
